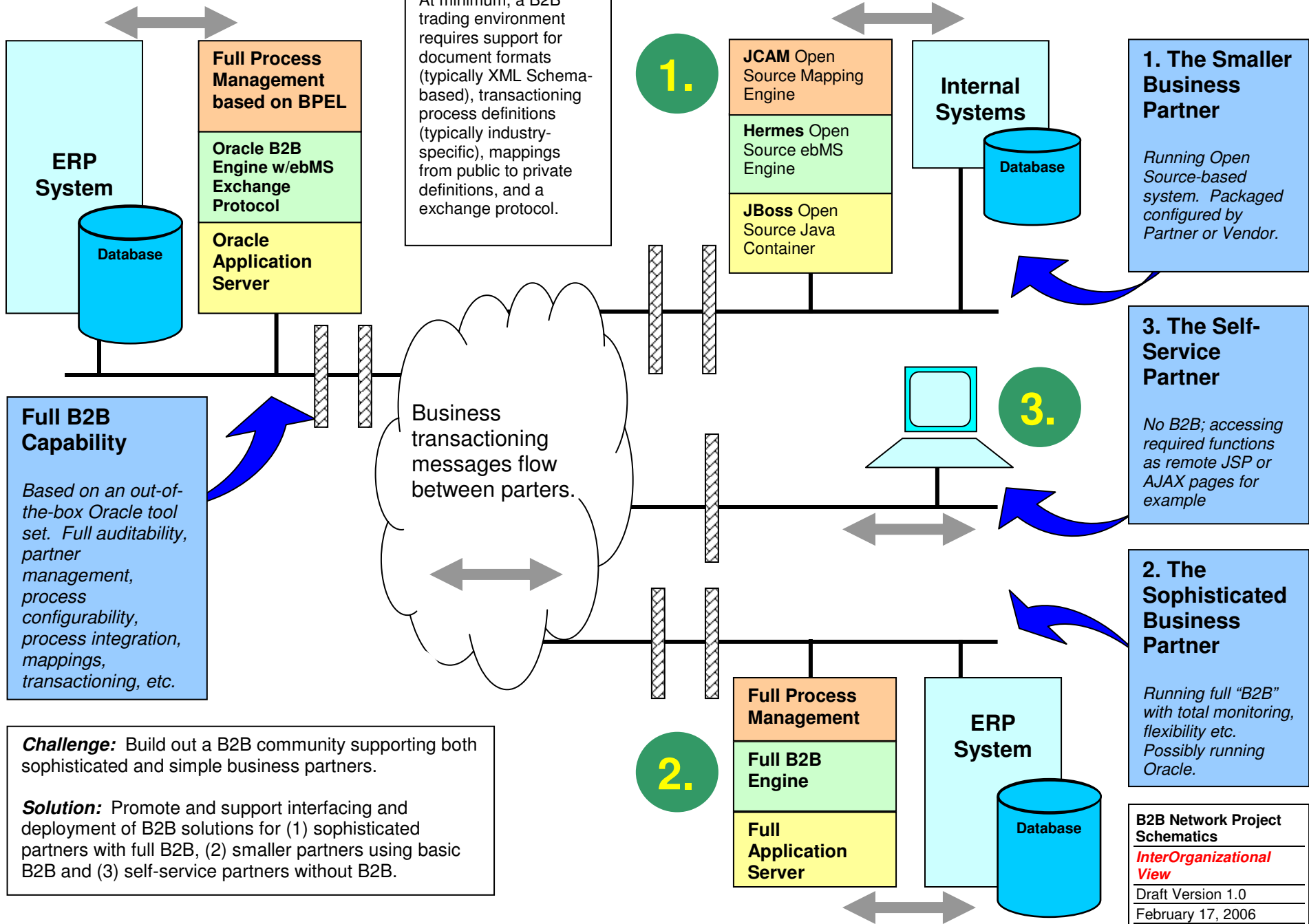


B2B Requirements

At minimum, a B2B trading environment requires support for document formats (typically XML Schema-based), transacting process definitions (typically industry-specific), mappings from public to private definitions, and an exchange protocol.

Full B2B Capability

Based on an out-of-the-box Oracle tool set. Full auditability, partner management, process configurability, process integration, mappings, transacting, etc.

Challenge: Build out a B2B community supporting both sophisticated and simple business partners.

Solution: Promote and support interfacing and deployment of B2B solutions for (1) sophisticated partners with full B2B, (2) smaller partners using basic B2B and (3) self-service partners without B2B.

1. The Smaller Business Partner

Running Open Source-based system. Packaged configured by Partner or Vendor.

3. The Self-Service Partner

No B2B; accessing required functions as remote JSP or AJAX pages for example

2. The Sophisticated Business Partner

Running full "B2B" with total monitoring, flexibility etc. Possibly running Oracle.
